THE PRIMARY PURPOSE OF THIS FOUNDATION

The corporation, known as Southern Lyon County Education Foundation is organized not for profit and the objects and purposes to be transacted and carried on are:

- (A) The primary purpose of the corporation is to aid, foster, and promote the development and welfare of the Southern Lyon County public schools in Olpe, Kansas, Hartford, Kansas, Neosho Rapids, Kansas, and the education and welfare of its students and faculty
- (B) To acquire, receive and obtain by gift, devise, purchase or other means
- (C) To hold the same, outright or in trust, for the uses and purposes herein stated and as required by the donor or testator
- (D) To control, manage and supervise all such property, making capital additions thereto or repairs thereon, and to receive the income there from, and disburse all such income
- (E) To sell, transfer, assign, alienate, convey, mortgage, encumber, pledge or otherwise dispose of all property of every kind
- (F) To construct erect buildings, equip the same, and rent property

HOW YOU CAN SUPPORT THE FOUNDATION

- Establish Endowments
- Donate money for designated or undesignated scholarship
- Donate money for programs

CHOOSE THE FUND THAT SUITS YOU

- **UNRESTRICTED FUNDS** provide money that is awarded in grants by the foundations Board of Trustees. It is a flexible way to meet a broad range of community needs, as determined by the Foundation
- **DESIGNATED FUNDS** allow donors to designate payment at the time of the gift to a charity, agency, or specific project

TYPES OF GIFTS

OUTRIGHT GIFTS are a simple, convenient way to donate and receive maximum tax advantages. Money, securities, personal property or real property are the usual gifts.

BEQUESTS of cash or property through a will are usually fully deductible for federal and state tax purposes. The Foundation also can be named as a residuary beneficiary of a charitable remainder trust created by the will.

LIFE INSURANCE with the Foundation as the irrevocable beneficiary of a life insurance policy, allows donors an immediate tax deduction in the amount of the cash value of the policy. Insurance premiums paid thereafter by the donor are deductible as a charitable gift.

MEMORIALS made in memory of deceased persons or in honor of living persons are generous testimonials.

CHARITABLE LEAD TRUSTS name the Foundation as the beneficiary of income from a trust for a specific number of years. The bulk of the trust, eventually goes to other named beneficiaries, such as children of grandchildren.

CHARITABLE REMAINDER TRUSTS enable the donor to provide a lifetime income to themselves or beneficiaries and leave the remainder of the estate to the Foundation.
